Dear Resident:

This letter is to inform you of an SRP construction project to upgrade the electrical service system in your neighborhood. This project is important to you in that it will enable SRP to continue providing safe and reliable power to your home.

The construction involves replacing old and damaged underground power lines and will require boring along South Lakeshore Drive between East Baseline Road and East Sandpiper Drive, and a small portion along South Lighthouse Lane (please see map on back). The work will require a technique called “guided boring” that allows crews to install the underground wire with minimal damage to the surface soil. Boring involves digging “pits” to connect each of the underground bored sections. We urge you and your children to take caution around construction areas as the work involves large equipment and other potentially hazardous conditions.

Through the duration of construction, crews will work with you to assure accessibility to your home. Please keep in mind that it is SRP’s policy to return all landscaping as close to its original condition as possible when the job is complete. Some curbside parking may be impacted during construction.

The boring and conduit installation portion will begin next week, and is expected to be completed by the middle of August. Please realize that start and completion dates are dependent upon weather and a number of other construction related issues. Every effort is made to prevent accidental outages; however, you may experience temporary power outages as crews disconnect existing lines and connect new lines.

We appreciate your cooperation concerning this project and apologize in advance for any inconvenience you might experience. It is SRP’s goal to continue delivering safe and reliable power to your neighborhood.
